



Hudson Berkshire Division Sponsored Bus Trip to Amherst Train Show Springfield Massachusetts January 25th 2025

Please fill out the attached form and make your checks payable to the **Hudson Berkshire Division** for the correct amount to reserve your place on the bus. Please **mail** your form and check to our Division PO Box, as indicated below. The cost, including show admission ticket, for a Hudson Berkshire NMRA member (and any NMRA member guest) is \$25, and for a non-NMRA member invited guest it will be \$37. The bus will make stops in Wilton, Clifton Park and Albany (**NOTE: new pickup/drop-off location by Crossgates Mall – more details to follow)** to pick up and drop off riders. We will be making one stop on the Mass Pike each way - there will be no stop for a formal dinner on the way home. The bus will make a stop at a rest area on the Mass Pike and refreshments may be purchased at that time.

Seats on the bus are on a first come, first served basis starting at the November Meeting. The bus trip is on and we still have some seats available – if you still want to go, PLEASE send in your signup form and check ASAP!

If the Division does cancel those who signed up will get a full refund, although we cannot refund individuals who sign up and then cannot make the trip.
